**UNIFORM POLICY** 

I. PURPOSE

Agamim Classical Academy maintains an official standard of dress, complete with a school uniform that must

be worn every day. The Academy has a primary objective of developing a school dedicated to the highest standards

of academics and deportment, and the uniform policy and dress code underscores the Academy's seriousness of

purpose by encouraging students to think of their attire as an aspect of their work. Uniforms help to eliminate self-

consciousness and social competition; place the emphasis for school culture on scholarship; and foster a sense of

identity within Agamim.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

Agamim Classical Academy students are expected to be in uniform on a daily basis. (Administration may

designate a limited number of non-uniform days.) It is the responsibility of the parents to ensure that the student

adhere to this policy. The administration will develop uniform guidelines that specify what items are appropriate

for students at each stage. Teachers, with assistance from the administration, will enforce these guidelines. School

uniforms are required for school-sponsored activities, such as field trips, school pictures, and concerts unless

exempted at the discretion of school Administration.
