

Agamim Safe Learning Plan for COVID-19

Overview

1. For the 2022-2023 school year, Agamim Classical Academy recommends layered COVID mitigation to avoid school spread. Agamim will reduce school spread by using self-screening at home, monitoring sickness at school, and requiring isolation for positive cases. Agamim asks that families consider masking during periods of COVID outbreak at school. Agamim will not contact trace for COVID nor require quarantine for exposure.

COVID Symptoms

2. Staff and students are asked to stay home with any of the following symptoms. COVID symptoms include: a fever over 100.4, severe cough, severe sore throat, muscle or body aches, new loss of taste or smell, nausea, or vomiting. Students will be sent home with a fever or vomiting, and the school may call parents about any of the above symptoms to request pick up.

Testing

3. Agamim recommends testing for COVID when staff or students show any of the COVID symptoms listed above. Symptomatic children may be sent home with a COVID rapid test to make testing accessible and easy for families. Staff and students who test positive must stay home while symptoms persist.

Isolating with COVID

4. Staff and students who test positive for COVID must isolate for 5 days at home and then wear a mask for the next 5 days. If symptoms persist, they must continue to isolate.

Workplan for Families in Isolation

- **5.** Families must contact the teachers and/or the school to request materials.
- **6.** Two school days maximum are needed for staff to gather all materials and create assignments for lower and upper school students in isolation.
- **7.** If families need a device, please contact the office.
- 8. If families need materials delivered, the school may provide an option for this.
